- Item 6 - Old Business
- A. Waste Collection and Recycling Services Request for Qualification (RFQ).
Amy briefed the Commission on the status of the new trash contract that
would be effective September 1, 2017. Council approved the release of
the RFQ at the July 6, 2016 meeting and the deadline for submittal is
August 25, 2016. The shortlist of firms that are qualified to respond to the
Request for Proposal (RFP) should be available at the September
Environmental Commission meeting.
- City Council award of contract is scheduled for the first meeting in
December 2016 to allow a new hauler at least 6 months for start-up.

- B. Sanitation Districts of Los Angeles County Wastewater Facility. Karl

treatment facility or a harbor cruise to evaluate the water quality of treated
effluent that is released into the harbor.
