Engineering Manager Mazboudi provided an update on the newly installed flashing stop signs to make them more visible to drivers. He also discussed multiple improvements and traffic studies being conducted:

- Atlantic Blvd. closure should reopen early December. Secondary study will be conducted to analyze the impact of the development on the traffic on Hellman & Atlantic Avenue
- Study is being conducted on Avenida Cesar Chavez & Schoolside Avenue to see if a left turn pocket lane could be added to both directions of the intersection
- Study is almost completed on Orange Avenue near Garvey Ranch Park and the report is expected to be ready early next week
- Study on Floral Avenue (from Atlantic to Monterey Pass Road) for traffic calming measures
