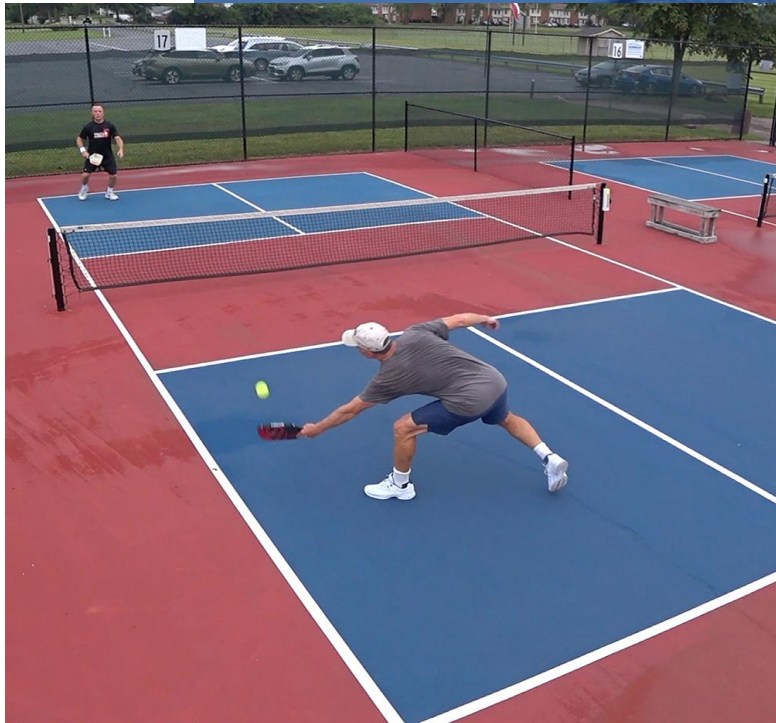












Current Design
