Engineering Manager, Ziad Mazboudi, provided an overview on 1st Riggins-Potrero Grande Corridor Project. City held three community outreach meetings and received excellent comments. Originally, project included Class 2 bike lanes along Potrero Grande and residents has expressed concerns regarding riding bicycles near high-speed cars could result in potential unsafe conditions for drivers and provide success factors to include the following:

- Create physical separation between bicycle lanes and car lanes
- Clear visibility for bike priority corridors
- Improve street intersections

Among the proposed changes to the project:

- Modify the project to include class 4 bike lanes along Potrero Grande
- Modify the proposed route at Atlantic from original (Riggins to Atlantic to First) to (Riggins to Cesar Chavez to Collegian to 1st)
