The Monterey Highlands' 2013-2014 mock trial team competed in the Constitutional Rights Foundation's November 2013 mock trial competition (People vs. Rae Concha), which was the trial of Rae Concha, a high school graduate, who faced two felony counts: second degree murder for the death of fellow student Jason Johnson and the possession of a controlled substance with the intent to sell the drug. Out of 44 middle schools participating in the competition, Monterey Highlands made it to the top 4 and thus qualified and competed in the semifinals (top 4). Monterey Highlands also received two individual awards: an individual witness award and a journalism award. The students are to be congratulated for their hard work, outstanding effort, and dedication to Monterey Highlands school and the mock trial team.
